In-Country/In-Region programme (ICIR)

Who can apply?	 Graduates and postgraduates from Sub-Saharan Africa with a first academic degree if applying for a Master's programme, or with a Master's degree if applying for a doctoral programme who want to pursue Master's or PhD courses in their home country (so called In-Country scholarships) or in another Sub-Saharan African country (In-Region scholarships).
Objective	 The objective of this scholarship programme is to promote the development of university teaching staff in universities and build capacity for staff in the public sector through postgraduate training in selected postgraduate study programmes
What can be funded?	 Postgraduate Courses at selected partner Universities or Research Institutions within Eastern Africa: www.daad.or.ke/en/find-funding/scholarship- programmes-within-east-africa/
Duration of funding	 Master programmes: 12 - 24 months Doctoral programmes: 36 months
Value	 Tuition Fees Annual Research Allowance Monthly Stipends Health Insurance/Travel Allowance (In-Region Only) Possibility of a one month summer school and/or a study visit of up to 6 months to Germany within the period of the scholarship.
Application Deadline	 Application generally runs from 15th October to 15th December. All applications must be submitted to the respective universities/ institutions
